## TV, INTERNET & WiFi POLICY

### 1. Acceptable use of computer/internet services in Peaslake Village Hall.

All Hall users are entitled to use the services. However, if you are under 16 years of age you will need the permission of your parent or guardian to use the internet.

### 2. Users' responsibilities:

Please be aware of the following:

2.1 Internet access at the Hall is filtered. However, we cannot guarantee all undesirable material will be blocked and the filter may occasionally block sites of interest.

2.2 The internet is not a secure medium and third parties may be able to obtain information regarding your activities. Be aware of this when transmitting confidential information such as address or credit card details.

2.3 You are not permitted to watch, record or download live television – either broadcast or streamed media, nor anything on BBC iPlayer, within the Hall or its grounds on any device [connected to the Hall's electricity supply](#) as per TV Licensing rules.

2.5 Inappropriate use of the Wireless Network is not permitted. This policy does not enumerate all possible inappropriate uses but rather presents some guidelines (listed below) that Peaslake Village Hall Committee of Management may at any time use to make a determination that a particular use is inappropriate:

(a) Users must respect the integrity of our network and any other public or private computing and network systems.

(b) The Wireless Network must not be used for malicious, fraudulent, misrepresentative purposes or activities in any way illegal under current law, nor

for activity which is defamatory, threatening or intimidating or which could be classed as harassment, or contains obscene, profane or abusive language or contains pornographic material whether in writing, pictures, films or video clips, or offensive material regarding sex, race, religion or any disability or sexual orientation.

(c) Nothing may be installed or used that modifies, disrupts, or interferes in any way with service for any user, host, or network.

(d) Users must not infringe third party rights.

### **3. Intellectual property/Copyright**

3.1 All forms of material contained on the internet, unless otherwise stated, are protected by copyright.

3.2 You are responsible for observing the conditions of copyright on each site you visit. Users must respect the privacy and intellectual property rights of others. Peaslake Village Hall does not accept liability should you breach copyright law.

### **4. The Hall Committee:**

4.1 Is not responsible for the accuracy, completeness or appropriateness of the information supplied on the internet.

4.2 Does not accept responsibility or liability for any claim, loss or damage resulting from your use of the service and any user therefore you must assume full responsibility for you and your guests using these services and you agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Committee of Peaslake Village Hall and each member thereof against any such claim, loss or damage.

4.3 Reserves the right for any Committee Member to deny user access to the internet service and to terminate any connection of anyone carrying out an activity they deem unacceptable, or to subject matter which they deem unsuitable, for a public environment. We also reserve the right to monitor sites visited by members of the public and report misuse to the appropriate authorities.

Any breach of these conditions may result in the withdrawal of future access to the internet using Hall facilities and may also result in withdrawal of your Hall bookings.
